- Colerain Avenue (north of Elam)
- Comfort Street • Cook Street
- Ethan Avenue • Garrard Street
- Meeker Street • Sassafras Street
- Monmouth Street (Colerain to Spring Grove)
- Sidney Ave. (Marshall to Hopple)

This work includes grinding off the old roadway surface, resurfacing the pavement with new asphalt, and repairing/replacing curbs.
