We have had a rash of problems caused by a small group of children 10 years and under. These kids have come into the neighborhood recently, through poorly-run rental units. They are both black and white kids, with little parental supervision. They have yelled at residents, knocked on windows late at night, rang door bells only to run off, thrown eggs at houses, let the air out of car tires, broken a car window, spilled paint on the street, trespassed in yards, and other obnoxious behavior.

We will be press the police to take action, get the parented involved, and, will ask landlords to do a better job screening tenants.

## Proper Garbage Set-up Is Important to the Cleanliness of Camp - Call 591-6000

Does it seem that Camp is seriously filthy with litter and garbage this winter? The streets seem to be always full of blowing trash, paper, plastic bottles, snack bags!

I appreciate when you and your neighbors help pick up litter in front of your own house, but one thing we all can do is have proper garbage set-out, including calling the City at 591-6000 to pick up big trash items like furniture, mattresses, appliances.



The City's new FIX IT CINCY mobile app is a great way to report not only garbage, litter, but abandoned cars, houses with building issues.



If you have overflowing cans, the City public works will not empty the cart. The cart remains full, often blocking the sidewalk, and even attracting other trash. Even though you may get fined, garbage blown out of the overflowing only adds to the litter on the streets.

Big items are simple to get rid of with the City's new garbage policy. You can go online to [www.5916000.com](http://www.5916000.com) and schedule pick ups.

We have also noticed some that apartment building owners and renters illegally setting out their full garbage cans in front of other neighbor's houses. This happened on

Henshaw recently, where the owner of a house that had burned stuffed burnt furniture in neighbor's cans. This resulted in the City NOT emptying the overflowing neighbor's carts, leaving them on the sidewalk.



## Call 765-1212 Police Dispatch to Report Illegal Panhandlers at Hopple Exits

Before the revamping of the Hopple Interchange, we had a good stretch of few panhandlers at the Exit 3 ramps off I-75. Residents and employers often called 765-1212 dispatch to report panhandlers at the ramps. Homeless and drug-prevention professionals all agree that giving money to panhandlers is a bad idea. Much of the money is used to buy heroin, not feed the homeless.

The ramps are full of panhandlers now, trying re-establish a stronghold for begging. The beggars often leave trash where they stand, further degrading the new ramp.
