On April 25th, Wave Pool will be hosting the premier of **Stretch of the Imagination**, a psychedelic yoga webisode series for tweens and young adults, created by Camp artist Amanda Checco. The screenings will take place at 6pm, 7:30pm, and 9pm.

Wave Pool also hosts **monthly critique nights** for local artists on the last Thursday of every month. All artists are welcome to come and bring a piece or two of what they are currently working on to discuss in a casual peer-review group discussion. Our next critique night is April 30th from 7-9pm.

## Judge Marsh Lets Grafitti Tagger Off Easy

We had high hopes that one of Cincinnati's most prolific taggers - Travis Barbour from Northside - was being sentenced March 12. The tag "BC CAPER JOINT" was found on several buildings along the I-75 corridor, including on the massive "Ryerson" building on Spring Grove Avenue. His grafitti marks have costs business owners several thousands of dollars. Also, he has cost taxpayers dearly as public service, cops, courts deal with him.

The grafitti artist got off easy as Judge Melba Marsh fined him \$250. That's less than a City permit costs to remdiate the damage! No community service, no pay back to fix the damage, no public shaming.
