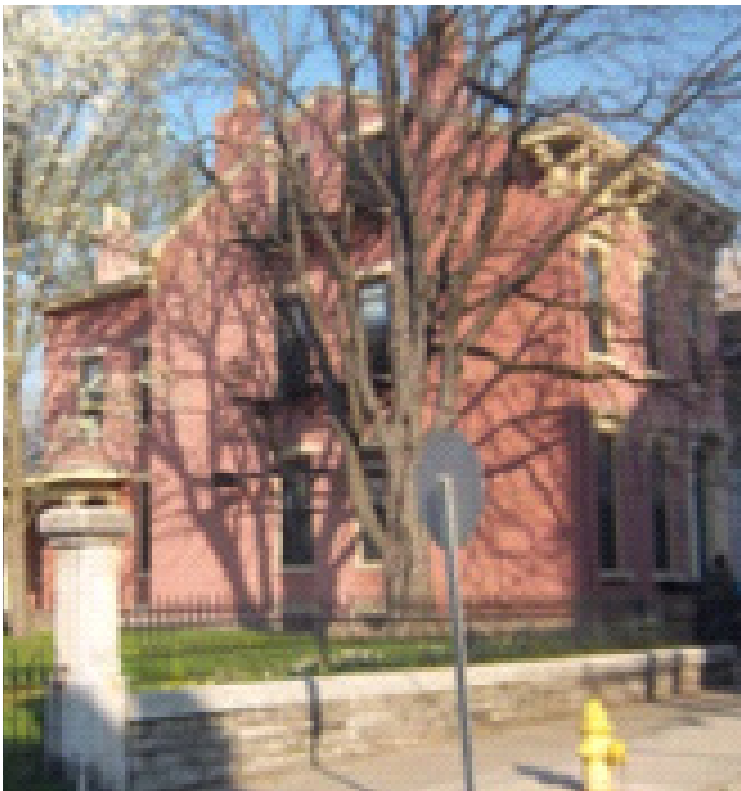

## City Garbage & Recycling Changes Still Confusing For Some

The Camp Washington Community Council was pleased with the City's new garbage & recycling pick up procedure, yet we knew there would be kinks to deal with. First, people need to stop over-filling the garbage cans so the lid closes. This is made easier if you use the recycling bin appropriately. Some people stuff garbage in the recycling bin instead of recyclables. These cans will not be picked up and emptied.

Multi-unit apartment owners must now provide garbage removal with contracted private companies (i.e. Rumpke). The removal of big items - mattresses, box springs, furnishings, couches, etc. - can only be removed by calling the City at 591-6000. (You can also visit the City website at [www.5916000.com](http://www.5916000.com) to schedule removals.) There is a waiting time of about six weeks for removal of these big items, so plan ahead and keep the stuff off the sidewalks until close to the removal date.
