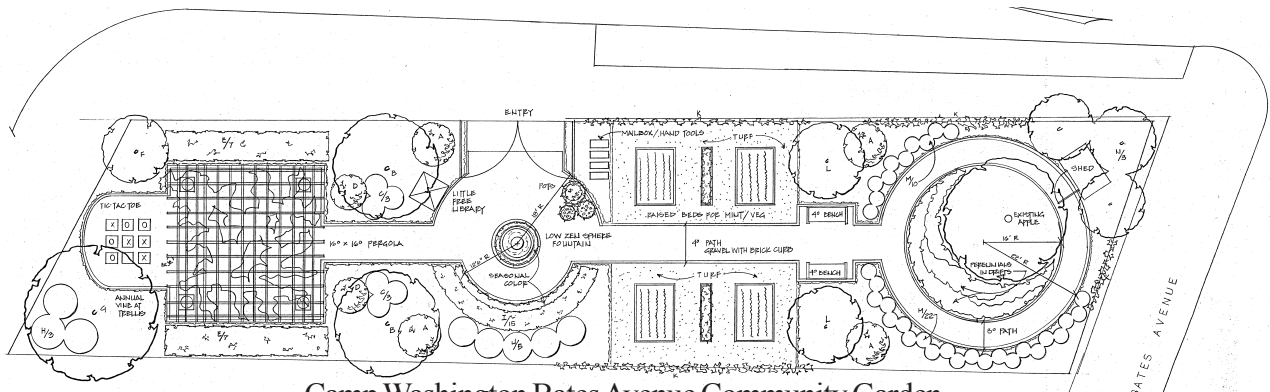

Washington UCC to Hire Summer Vista Staff

The Camp Washington United Church of Christ has been awarded a summer staff position through VISTA (Volunteers in Service to America). The job is kitchen assistant, from June 1 to Aug. 12. The hours are 6:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. Monday-Thursday, and 5-9 p.m. Sundays.

The stipend is \$973 a month. At the end of service, the VISTA member will receive either a cash bonus of about \$280 or an education award for college tuition/student loans of \$1,222. Housing at the church may be available.

The City's **YOUTH 2 WORK PROGRAM** is a consortium of City departments, local nonprofits and partner organizations working to recruit, train and employ youth.

The eight-week program provides job readiness and life skills training to Cincinnati youth between the ages of 14-18. Youth will work between 20-30 hours a week from June to August earning \$8.10 per hour.

Youth are placed in career-oriented employment opportunities such as law enforcement, fire and safety, horticulture, recreation, art, technology and administration.
